#### WHAT WILL YOU REAP?

With Labor Day over, it is now the period of the year when we begin to transition from summers warmth to fall's embrace. Now is the time of harvesting all of the fruits and vegetables that have been growing so well all spring and summer and beginning to prepare for the cooler days that lead up to winter. With the season of harvest coming ever so close I wonder, how fruitful have you been?

When Paul looked at his life, he only had one goal in mind. That goal was to bear fruit. And he recognized how direct that connection was between being able to bear fruit and working hard. Fruit will not come if there is no labor. And the intensity, dedication, and patience of that labor will have obvious effects on the level of fruit. Just like a plant can show you the hard work and dedication of the farmer by showing how much fruit it produces, when it comes to our labor for the Lord, it too can be seen by looking at the fruit that has resulted.

Is your spiritual fruit comparable to the labor? Are you satisfied with the fruit you are bearing? Do you feel as though your labor is pleasing to the Lord, or could you possibly be bearing more fruit? Jesus tells us in **John 15:5-6** "I am the vine; you are the branches. Whoever abides in me and I in him, he it is that bears much fruit, for apart from me you can do nothing. If anyone does not abide in me he is thrown away like a branch and withers; and the branches are gathered, thrown into the fire, and burned."

Some of us may be bearing no fruit at all...some may be bearing a little...some may be bearing a lot. The reality is that each of us can bring forth more fruit than we are right now, but this will require more labor on our part. What is your purpose and goal in life? Paul said his goal was, in **Philippians 1:21-22**, "For to me to live is Christ, and to die is gain. If I am to live in the flesh, that means fruitful labor for me. Yet which I shall choose I cannot tell." Is your goal the same? Let us make sure that we labor in the fields of this world and help spread the seed of the gospel of Christ. Because the harvest is coming and we want to be fruitful. "And let us not grow weary of doing good, for in due season we will reap, if we do not give up." **Galatians 6:9** Andrew Spivey
