This story tells a lot in relation to the heart of man. Much too often, we think that we can solve everything by simply changing the outside. As long as it looks good, then it doesn't matter about anything else. It's like living in a mansion with no power and inflatable furniture. But at least you have the mansion.

There are many who can do that in their spiritual life as well. In the time of Christ, there was one particular group who did this often. The Pharisees and Jesus called them out clearly and often. In Matthew 23:25-28 Jesus says, "Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you clean the outside of the cup and the plate, but inside they are full of greed and self-indulgence. You blind Pharisee! First clean the inside of the cup and the plate, that the outside also may be clean. Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you are like whitewashed tombs, which outwardly appear beautiful, but within

are full of dead people's bones and all uncleanness. So, you also outwardly appear righteous to others, but within you are full of hypocrisy and lawlessness."

Sure, they looked holy and clean on the outside and to others, but inside they were spiritually dead. With such a harsh statement coming from Jesus, it is obvious how He felt about the hypocrisv that they were living under, only caring about appearances and only taking care of what people could see. But how often do we find ourselves in similar situations? If we go to church on Sunday and act holy and spiritual, but the rest of week act like the Devil, then we are as much of a hypocrite as the scribes and Pharisees. God isn't concerned with what other people see on the outside, He interested on what He sees on the inside. He knows what's really inside and how sincere we are about our worship of Him and our relationship with Him. 1 Samuel 16:7 reads, "But the Lord said to Samuel, "Do not look on his appearance or on the height of his stature, because I have rejected him. For the Lord sees not as man sees: man looks on the outward appearance, but the Lord looks on the heart." We can fool other people, but we can't fool God. We can dress up in our Sunday finest and play the part, but when we stand before God on judgment day, He will know if we are full of dead men's bones or filled with His love. He will know if we have the heart of His son or the heart of a mouse.
